Please Pray Purposefully:


People – Luke 10:2 says, "...pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest." While many are not answering the call of God on their lives, most are not earnestly praying for laborers. As you pray through the world map, pray that the Lord would raise up laborers for those nations.

Purpose – 2 Thessalonians 3:1 says, "...pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified..." First, pray for the missionary and his family (physical, emotional, financial, and spiritual needs). Second, pray for the word of God to go forth with power in their ministry. Last but not least, pray that the Scriptures and the Saviour would be glorified!

Protection – The next verse (2 Thess. 3:2) gives another prayer pointer: "And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men:" Missionaries have spiritual and physical opposition. Pray that they will not succumb to failure.

Power – In Ephesians 6:18-19 we find another prayer pointer. "Praying always…that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel," For a missionary to be truly successful he must have the power of God upon his life. Pray for power!
